CHECK LIST

- 1._____ “Keep Brockton Beautiful” Day – April 25, 2009 /Registration 7:30am – 9:00am
Clean Up Time 9:00am – Noon (Rain or Shine)
- 2._____ Arrange for transportation to and from Heights Crossing on “Keep Brockton Beautiful” Day (KBB Day). **Use Christy’s Drive from Pleasant Street to get to Heights Crossing—Do Not Use Reynolds Memorial Highway (Rte 27) entrance.**
- 3._____ Prepare a Team List and present it to registration table at Heights Crossing on KBB Day. **Also, leave a cell phone number and contact person for the team with the registration desk.**
- 4._____ Pick up KBB Day t-shirts for each of your team members and make sure they wear them during the clean up.
- 5._____ Make sure each team member (or if children are involved, their parents) have completed the liability waiver form and present the completed forms at the registration table. **No Team Member can participate unless they complete the form!**
- 6._____ If possible, bring your own rakes, brooms and shovels. Gloves, plastic bags, and biodegradable bags will be provided at the registration table.
- 7._____ You will receive your assignment at the registration table and then proceed to your assigned area.
- 8._____ Make sure volunteers are advised not to pick up certain items (See “DO NOT PICK UP” List).
- 9._____ Proceed with clean up and place plastic and /or biodegradable bags at the assigned area for pick up.
- 10._____ **When finished, do a head count and then proceed to Heights Crossing, 35 Christy’s Place for a cook out!**

This is a Release and Waiver of Liability executed on this date by:

The Volunteer hereby freely, voluntarily, and without duress executes this Release under the terms below: In consideration of the opportunity to volunteer, the Volunteer does hereby release and forever discharge and hold harmless the City of Brockton and its agents, servants and employees from any and all liability, claims, costs, expenses, judgments and demands of whatever kind of nature, directly or indirectly, either in law or in equity, which arise or may hereafter arise from his/her activities with the City of Brockton.

The Volunteer understands that the activities include work that may be hazardous to the Volunteer, and hereby expressly and specifically assumes the risk of injury or harm in the activities and releases the City of Brockton from all liability for injury, illness, death or property damage resulting from the activities. The Volunteer also understands that the City of Brockton does not assume any responsibility for or obligation to provide financial assistance or other assistance, including but not limited to medical, health, or disability insurance in the event of injury or illness to any volunteer.

The Volunteer does hereby release and forever discharge the City of Brockton from any claim whatsoever which arises or may hereafter arise on account of any first aid, treatment, or service rendered in connection with the Volunteer's activities with the City of Brockton on "Keep Brockton Beautiful Day".

Volunteer agrees that in the event that any clause or provision of this Release shall be held to be invalid by any court of competent jurisdiction, the invalidity of such clause or provision shall not otherwise affect said Release.
